**Short-Term Recommendations**

- Develop a clear and understandable decision tree and supporting documentation would improve the transparency of the county's program. (*substantial staff time with outside assistance*)
- Implement a process to get important new information and to update its PUP and policies each year as needed. (*variable staff time*)
- Generate simple but effective tables, linked with maps, that describe its sampling and treatment activates each year. (*<\$1,000: use consultant*)
- Provide information in the PUP in a more easily understood manner, including how products fit into the county's program. (*substantial staff time with outside assistance*)
- Clarify policies; make the complexities of mosquito control more understandable to the public. (*substantial staff time with outside assistance*)
- Collaborate with ODFW to identify ecologically sensitive areas and scale mosquito control work accordingly. (*variable staff time*)

**Long-Term Recommendations**

- Document effectiveness of mosquito control in preventing human disease in the northwest. (*variable staff time, partnerships*)
- Work with other jurisdictions to reach agreement when objectives are in conflict. (*substantial staff time initially*)
- Develop innovative solutions to reduce workload and save resources. (*variable staff time, partnerships*)
- Form partnerships with government and academic institutions in the area to explore non-target effects of its work. (*variable staff time, partnerships*)
